I'm pleased to invite you to an introduction to the newly launched (May 2026) **Web of Science Research Intelligence (WoSRI)**, Clarivate's new AI-native platform designed to support institutional funding strategy, collaboration, and research impact.

WoSRI brings together data from Clarivate products you may already use including **Web of Science, Journal Citation Reports, InCites Benchmarking & Analytics**, and **Pivot-RP**. Soon, the platform will expand to include [Cortellis](#) clinical trial data, [Derwent](#) patent data, as well as non-traditional research outputs such as locally managed institutional data, societal impact indicators and news mentions from [ProQuest Historical Newspapers](#).

With a transparent [societal impact framework](#) and trusted, unified data spanning publications, patents, grants, policy documents, clinical trials, and more, WoSRI offers a holistic, evidence-based view of research performance.

The solution is designed to help institutions:

- Surface emerging research strengths aligned to institutional priorities
- Identify funding and collaboration opportunities
- Connect topics, experts, and funding in one unified view
- Monitor and assess performance across the research lifecycle
- Demonstrate societal impact with transparent, evidence-based indicators

More than 45 universities worldwide have already partnered with us to shape and use the solution. The University of Manitoba was our first development partner, helping ensure early development reflecting Canadian needs. Through this workshop, we hope to continue that conversation and gather input from Canadian institutions to guide the ongoing evolution of WoSRI.

During this interactive session, we'll provide a live walkthrough, share insights from early partner institutions, and gather your feedback.
